GRAFT + Kleihues+Kleihues Design Work/Live Housing in Berlin

GRAFT and **Kleihues+Kleihues** has teamed up with **Genossenschaft für urbane Kreativität** (Cooperative for urban Creativity) to realize a complex of five towers centered around working and living in Berlin, **Germany**. Titled “Eckwerk,” the new complex is set to rise within the confines of an existing viaduct, whose shape and materiality served as the project’s main source of inspiration.

Supported by a two-story, brick pedestal, the tower’s ground level is elevated to the same height of the viaduct. This, like a “city balcony,” provides uninterrupted views of an adjacent stream, while establishing an internal pedestrian streetscape that extends into the public. Each tower is connected through a “experience path” which hosts a variety of areas dedicated to exchange and relaxation.

Both the floor plans and facades exhibit modular design principles, which allow for individual modification and adaptation.
